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What is the Real Estate Agent's job?

- They help you define what is important to you and your family
- The agent provides current information to make your home search easier
- The agent will make appointments for you to see available houses
- The agent helps you write a purchase offer and negotiate with the seller for the best price

Real estate agents provide many important functions in the real estate transaction. They are there to represent your best interests and provide trusted advice on the purchase of your new home.

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What does a professional home inspection include?

- Once the offer is accepted, you should hire a professional home inspector to inspect the structural soundness of all major systems of the property
- If there are items that need to be repaired, then work with your real estate agent to negotiate these issues
- Once repairs are made there may be a second home inspection

Many buyers overlook this critical step. Be familiar with what elements are being inspected. A home inspection may protect you from costly repairs in the future.

What is the purchase contract and what does it include?

- The price, the amount of earnest money, legal names of buyers and sellers, the closing date as well as any contingencies of the contract
- Specifies any items that stay with the property
- A time limit for the seller to accept the offer and what due diligence means
